
Set up Overdrive on Your iPhone, iPad, or iPod


STEP 1

Go to the iTunes, in the search box, type in Overdrive. In your results, locate the Overdrive Media Console, download and open the new app.




STEP 2

Create Account, or sign in to an account that you previously made. You can sign in with your library card, Facebook, or create a username and password.




STEP 3

STEP 4


Select the back arrow until you return to the account screen and the menu symbol appears. Press the menu symbol to navigate through Overdrive.











Place a Hold on a Book



Using the menu, navigate to Simi Valley Public Library. Click the magnifying glass to search. Enter your search terms and press the magnifying glass again.








STEP 4
